

Year 2 Summer Term Curriculum Map (First Half)



MATHS

Children will investigate statistics and interpret data. They will also explore money and making an amount with different coins.

Key Vocabulary: pence, pound, silver, copper, pictogram, bar chart, data, axis.

GEOGRAPHY

Children will choose their own non-European country to research and compare to the UK.

Key Vocabulary: compare, similarities, differences, country.

COMPUTING

Children will explore algorithms and the importance of following instructions in a specific order. They will program a floor robot.

Key Vocabulary: instructions, algorithms, execute, esafety.



ENGLISH

Children will use The Enchanted Wood by Enid Blyton to write descriptions. They will also re-tell a chapter from the story before planning and writing their own 'new' chapter.

Key Vocabulary: fiction, description, adjectives, debate.

ART

Children will create an abstract sculpture inspired by Barbara Hepworth. They will carve and shape clay to create their model.

Key Vocabulary: sculptor, sculpture, carve, shape, artist.

MUSIC

Children will create and perform accompaniments to songs and rhymes linked to journeys. They will listen and respond to pieces of music and explain how a composer can depict the speed of transport within each piece.

Key Vocabulary: beat, tempo, rhythm, sequence, music.

RE

Children will discuss the idea that Christians believe that Jesus brings good news to his followers. They will hear stories from the Bible about his disciples.

Key Vocabulary: Christians, Jesus, disciples, messages, news.

SCIENCE

Children will identify and describe the basic structure of a range of common flowering plants and trees. They will investigate the features that plants need to grow.

Key Vocabulary: plant, conditions, deciduous, evergreen.

PΕ

Children will develop their co-ordination, control and movements within dance lessons. They will move rhythmically and respond to music to create short sequences.

Key Vocabulary: dance, co-ordination, sequence, dance.

PSHE / RSE

Children will learn how babies develop into to older adults. They will learn that a baby is grown inside a female and what babies and young children need to be looked after. The children will name body parts.

Key Vocabulary: body parts, baby, toddler, child, teenager, adult, elderly adult
