



## ENGLISH

The children will be developing narrative and informative writing skills inspired by the Beast Quest series. They will continue to develop their understanding of spelling rules and grammar. **Key Vocabulary: non-chronological report, paragraph, subheading** 

#### GEOGRAPHY

Children will complete a showcase project by identifying and describing specific volcanoes within Europe. **Key Vocabulary: Volcano, Vent, Magma, Secondary vent, Lava, Chamber, Crater, Fissure, molten, cone, pyroclastic flow, Europe** 

#### COMPUTING

The children will continue to use basic programming software.

Key Vocabulary: Scratch, de-bug, coding, programming, algorithm

## FRENCH

The children will be learning parts of the body in French through the re-telling of Little Red Riding Hood. **Key Vocabulary: Petit Chaperon Rouge, la maison, la grand-mère, le loup, le bûcheron, la forêt, les parents, la tête, la gorge, les dents, le ventre, la bouche, les épaules** 

#### MATHS

The children will develop their understanding of written methods by using the column method for subtraction. They will also learn about multiplication with a focus on the 2, 4 and 8 times tables. **Key Vocabulary: subtrahend, minuend, difference, exchange, factor, product** 



# MUSIC

The children will continue with weekly recorder lessons and develop their singing skills.

Key Vocabulary: note, tempo, rhythm, crotchets, rests, quavers, rounds, partner songs

## RE

The children will learn about some Jewish festivals and how Jewish people view God. **Key Vocabulary: Rosh Hashanah, reflection, Shofar, tashlich, Atonement, fasting, repentance, deliverance, Yom Kippur, Exodus, Pesach** 

## SCIENCE

The children will be learning about the lifecycle of plants, their requirements for life and growth, and how they transport water. **Key Vocabulary: Photosynthesis, pollen, insect/wind pollination, seed formation, seed dispersal – wind dispersal, animal dispersal, water** 

## PE

The children will be developing skills in gymnastics and netball. During the first two weeks of half-term, children will get the chance to partake in an intra-school boccia competition. **Key Vocabulary: Individual point balance, patch balances, rolls, barrel, tuck, star, throw, catch, intercept, shoot, pivot** 

#### PSHE

In PSHE children will learn the names of their private parts and how to keep themselves safe and clean.

Key Vocabulary: Penis, vagina, breasts, vulva, testicles, unique, personal hygiene, germs

#### ART

Children learn of the impressionist work of the artist Oscar Claude Monet. They will learn of the importance of colour and light and how to use a range of oil pastel techniques. **Key Vocabulary: Valuable, Radicle, Impressionist, Grand manner, Blend, Combine, Landscapes, Effect, Highlight,**
